evil.

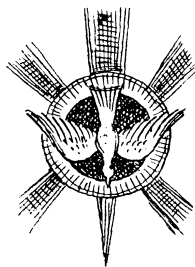
Priest: For Thine is the kingdom, and the power, and the glory:
